





GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS FOR DRILLING **HOLES IN HOLLOW-CORE PLANKS**


1. HOLES SHOULD BE DRILLED IN CORES WHEREVER POSSIBLE. (NOTE CUT SIDES OF PLANKS ARE MOST VISIBLE FROM THE UNDERSIDE)
















2. DO NOT CONCENTRATE HOLES AT ONE PLACE IN PLANK





- 3. OBVIOUSLY SOME CASES MIGHT INVOLVE CUTTING A WEB. IN GENERAL THIS MAY BE DONE IN PLANKS THAT MEET ALL OF THE FOLLOWING:
 - a) ONLY IN 4'-0" WIDE PLANKS
 - b.) ONLY CUT INTO TWO WEBS PER PLANK
 - c.) PLANKS WITH NO FACTORY CUT OPENINGS
- d.) PLANKS NOT SUPPORTING OTHER PLANKS
- e.) NO CLOSER THAN EVERY FOURTH PLANK
